# **PowerPoint Presentation**

Challenges to oil and gas infrastructure, particularly pipelines are on the rise. While President Trump's election cleared some permitting hurdles in Washington, it also supercharged opposition to fossil fuel infrastructure. With high growth in funding and membership since the election, opposition organizations have announced their intent to double down, and are executing aggressive state and local strategies to oppose where infrastructure is planned or under construction. To counter this, energy infrastructure industries must also raise their game for public support. EEIA is rolling out a campaign to mobilize support in the pipeline

construction, equipment, services and materials industries for this purpose, and Toby will share campaign plans and progress.
